## High Level Changes for the 2025 National Leadership Conference

- Updates to the number of devices that can be used during a preliminary and finals round. Competitors can present with up to two devices.
- External speakers are not allowed for preliminary presentation rounds.
- Links and QR codes are restricted items in pre-judge reports; links and QR codes during presentations are for display purposes only.
- Production events will happen on-site during the National Leadership Conference.

- Objective test has increased to 100 questions

## Database Design & Applications

- Event has been retired

## Digital Animation

- Video length has been reduced to 2 minutes

## Financial Math

- Formerly named Business Calculations
- Individual Event, Objective Test
- Event not eligible for those that placed in the top ten at previous NLCs in Business Calculations

- Clarification on event topic
- Lesson plan is not brought to the presentation round

## Future Business Leader

- Cover letter/resume is not brought to the presentation/interview round

## Competitive Event Definitions

Components	Description
Interview	The employer (judge) interviews the applicant (competitor) by asking typical job interview questions.
Objective Test	A timed objective online test. Non-graphing calculators may be used.
Prejudged	Content is judged before the conference. The presentation of a report or project is judged during the conference.
Presentation	The presentation of an individual or team's project, or campaign on a specific topic provided on the National Website. This topic changes each year.
Production Test	A timed computer production test administered and proctored at the home school prior to the RLC and/or SLC.
Role Play Team	Competitors receive a role play scenario prior to their time in front of judges. Judges receive a copy of the role play, along with suggested questions to ask during each performance.
Speech	A speech is prepared based on the given topic or topic of choice.

## North Carolina Scholarship Events

Scholarship Name	Eligibility
Alsup Business Scholarship	Only high school seniors taking an active part in the SLC are eligible. All applicants should plan to work toward a degree in business.
Barton College	Participants must be high school seniors planning to attend Barton College.
FBLA Professional Division Scholarship Award	
James L. White Scholarship	Only high school seniors taking an active part in the SLC are eligible. All applicants should plan to work toward a degree in business.
NC ACTE-BE Broyhill Scholarship	Applicants must be classified below the senior grade level in high school.
UNC-G Bryan School of Business Scholarship	Participants must be high school seniors planning to attend UNC-G in the year following the award and to select a major in the Bryan School of Business and Economics.

## North Carolina Awards

Title	Eligibility
Adviser of the Year Award	Nomination forms must be submitted to the respective Regional Board Member and State Adviser via email by December 15. Advisers should have at least 3 years of experience as an adviser for FBLA and have an active chapter. They will be required to complete a packet describing their commitment to their students and the organization as a whole. A committee of three persons will review submitted packets and the adviser with the highest score will be named Adviser of the Year.
Businessperson of the Year	Each region will submit their respective region's choice for Businessperson of the Year. From there, selection will be made by the NCFBLA Board to award the statewide title of Businessperson of the Year.
Largest Local Chapter Award	Official membership numbers from FBLA Connect will determine the Largest Local Chapter Award. The cutoff date for membership for this award is January 22.
NC FBLA Honorary Life Member	Any active member or adviser can nominate a person for Honorary Life Membership. Nominations should be sent to the State Adviser by January 15.
NCBEA Outstanding Student Award	Participants may not enter the Who's Who in FBLA event.
Who's Who in FBLA	Participants must be enrolled in their senior year of high school. Who's Who candidates must have completed the Future level of the Business Achievement Award.

# North Carolina FBLA 2024-25 Competitive Events

## General Rules and Regulations

- Only paid, active members are allowed to compete at RLC, SLC, and NLC. Please refer to the annual calendar for membership deadlines.
- Members may participate in one chapter event and one individual or team event. Exceptions are made for these events:
  - o Students applying for a state office are permitted to compete in a team or individual event.
  - o A member nominated for "Who's Who in FBLA or other scholarship event may also compete in another event.
  - o Members participating in events with grade level restrictions or maximum-training limits, must submit a current transcript as proof of their eligibility.
- NO electronic equipment will be provided at NC SLC. This includes:
  - o Projectors
  - o Projection screens
  - o Drop cords, surge protectors, or other sources of electricity
- Competitors present directly from a device which includes a laptop, tablet, mobile phone, or external monitor (approximately the size of a laptop screen). Competitors can present with one or two devices. If presenting with two devices, one device must face the judges and one device must face the competitors.
- Projectors and projector screens are not allowed for use, and competitors are not allowed to bring their own.
- Registration must be completed by the chapter adviser via Blue Panda
- Failure to report on time to competitive events may result in disqualification.
- If a member places in the top 10 at a previous NLC, they are not allowed to compete in that event at any RLC or SLC.
- Throughout the conference, all members are expected to be in FBLA Dress Code.
- Participants should bring a copy of the prejudged material if they want to include it in their presentation.
- No audiences are allowed for preliminary or final events.
- Materials due prior to the conference must be submitted on time, according to the posted date. Late submissions may be disqualified.

## Participation Limits

- Team Events can consist of 1, 2, or 3 members.
- Chapter Events can consist of 1, 2, or 3 members.
- All Objective Test Only events have a limit of **4 members per chapter**.
